MODULE 6: MATERIALITY ASSESSMENT

This module exposes leaders on identifying and prioritising the most significant environmental, social, and governance (ESG) issues affecting their institutions aligning with institutional goals and university ranking framework to enhance sustainability reporting, strategic planning, and decision-making.

MODULE 7: SUSTAINABILITY PROGRAM

This module equips leaders with the knowledge and tools to design, implement, and manage effective sustainability initiatives within their institutions, while also addressing challenges and adopting best practices in fostering a culture of sustainability.
